**Directions:** The fastest and most direct route from the Meeting House in Boulder is 34 miles (through Lyons on US36) and usually takes 45-60 minutes. Alternative routes through Nederland, Ward or Jamestown are longer.

**From Boulder Friends Meeting House**, go north on Broadway and turn left on US-36 (Foothills Highway). In about 11 miles, turn left to stay on US-36. after about 1.5 miles, in Lyons, turn right to stay on US-36. follow for about 19 miles. Sharp right onto US-34 E/ Big Thompson Ave 1.1 miles. Turn right onto Lakefront Street 0.3 miles. 361 Lakefront Street is on the right.

**Parking:** Please carpool and park on the grass between Lakefront Street and the driveway parallel to the house, or in the parking area by the lake. **Please enter the house and yard ONLY by the 2<sup>nd</sup> driveway (on side of house next to lake and golf course).**

**Please feel free to use** all outdoor seating areas, including areas outside the sunroom and areas under the deck, sunroom and game room, the kitchenette and the downstairs bathroom. Another toilet is available a block's walk down to the lake at the Fisherman's Nook. **No entry to upstairs or by front door of house.** We will have potluck items outside on tables near door to game room.

**Please bring:** Your own beverage (ice chests available to keep drinks cool) and a potluck dish with serving utensils, if needed. Hats and sunscreen are recommended. Also, breezes sometimes make it chilly, so wraps are a good idea. **Provided:** We will provide paper plates, napkins, cups and utensils, coffee, decaf coffee, chilled black tea, chilled herbal tea and water. Folks may want to bring their own water bottles, especially if it is a sunny, hot day. Receptacles for trash and recycle will be available indoors and outdoors.

**To do:** Eat, drink and socialize with Friends. Walk down to the lake. Bring a bike and ride the bike path to downtown Estes about 1 mile away. Frisbees for frisbee golf, play outdoors; bring bubbles? Indoors is a game table and an amazing array of games, but who wants to be indoors in the summer in the mountains.
